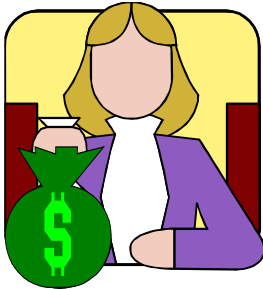
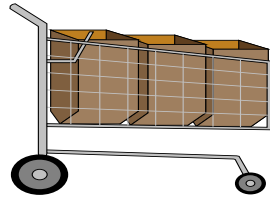
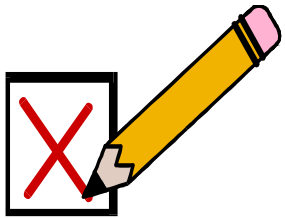
How do I sign up for services?
